Founded in 1901 by Seth Shiv Narayan Ji Birla as the 'Pathshala' for his grandsons, it has grown into a significant educational hub managed by the Birla Education Trust since 1929.

It became a Multipurpose Higher Secondary School in 1958 and adopted the 10+2 education pattern in 1975-76. 


